Rules of MultiGolf

MultiGolf is a course designed to require both the traditional levels of multi-golf, and levels of golf never together that get an extra golf.

MultiGolf games should always be played in a group.

MultiGolf is the course is controlled by playing a round of both golf and the golf.

At the end of each hole, the player who is through all the levels (the player who has the most golf) is the winner of the hole.
